



## How do Plants and Trees grow?

Key Vocabulary - Plants	
Seed	A seed is the small, hard part of a plant from which a <u>new</u> plant <u>grows</u> .
Leaf	Parts of a tree or plant that are flat, thin, and usually green. Many trees and plants <u>lose</u> their leaves in the <u>winter</u> and <u>grow</u> new leaves in the spring.
Root	The parts of the plant that grow under the ground.
Stem	The <b>stem</b> of a plant is the thin, upright part on which the flowers and leaves grow.
Flower	The part of a plant, which is often brightly coloured, grows at the end of a <u>stem</u> , and only <u>survives</u> for a short time.
Seedling	A seedling is a young plant that has been grown from a seed.
Trunk	The trunk of a tree is the large main stem from which the branches grow.
Branch	The <b>branches</b> of a tree are the parts that grow out from its trunk and have leaves, flowers, or <u>fruit</u> growing on them.
