Yr 6 Swimming Proficiency 2017-18

Cohort size - 24

Swim confidently over 25m - 79%

Use a range of strokes - 79%

Perform safe self-rescue - 88%

Those children who have not met the required standard have received 12 weeks of additional swimming lessons to enable them to become more water confident, as a result of this an extra 16% of the cohort met the standard.

The children who have still not met the standard will have more opportunities on the summer residential to develop in this area. The parents of these children have also been informed that they have not yet met the required standard.
