- 5. 3 consonants: heart; asked; learn; when; their. 4 consonants: recent; called; height; island; medicine.
- 6. Alannah is incorrect because she has not followed the second and last clues. The correct word is 'kitten' because it starts with a 'k', it has four consonants and two vowels. The double consonant is 't'.
