Key Vocabulary

Above	At a higher level or position to something else
Backwards	Towards the direction that is opposite to the one in which you are facing
Below	At a lower level or position to something else
Forwards	Towards or at a place ahead
Half (turn)	One of two equal parts
Next to	In or into a position to one side of
Position	The position of an object is its place or location When you put something in a certain place you position it.
Quarter (turn)	One of four equal parts
Turn	Move in a circular direction
underneath	Directly below

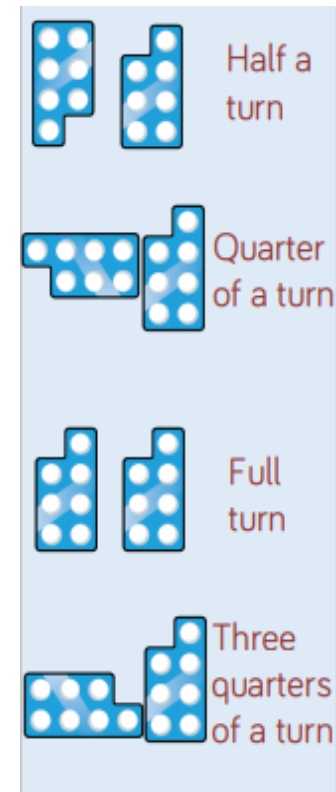

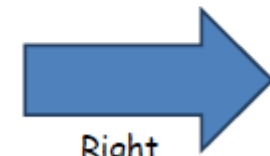
Forward
