### Key vocabulary

**Ash Wednesday** - the start of Lent

**Celebrate** - to do something special for an important event

**Crucified** - put on the cross

**Easter Sunday** - the day we celebrate that Jesus is alive

**Good Friday** - the day Jesus was put on the cross

**Jerusalem** - an important city where Jesus was crucified

**Lent** - 40 days from Ash Wednesday to Maundy Thursday

**Maundy Thursday** - the day before Good Friday

**Palm Sunday** - when Jesus came to Jerusalem riding on a donkey and people waved palm leaves

**Parade** - a group of people walking and celebrating

**Prepare** - get ready

**Promise** - to say you will definitely do something



### Key Facts:

- Lent lasts for 40 days.
- Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent.
- We can make a promise for Lent.
- The palm leaves from last year are burnt to make the ashes which are put on your forehead by the priest.
- The week from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday is called Holy Week.
