You already know about:

- **Palm Sunday** -when Jesus was welcomed into Jerusalem.
- **The Last Supper** - when Jesus shared a last meal with his friends, the disciples. He broke bread and they drank wine.
- **Good Friday** - when Jesus was put to death on a cross.



Key facts

Easter Sunday is when we celebrate that Jesus rose from the dead.

Mary Magdalene visited the tomb but found that the stone had been rolled away from the entrance.

An angel said that Jesus was alive and Mary saw the tomb was empty.

Peter and John also saw the empty tomb.

Jesus spoke to Mary in the garden but at first she did not know it was Him.

The disciples were hiding in a locked room, when suddenly **Jesus appeared** to them. He said, "Peace be with you."

He ate fish with them to prove that He was real.

Thomas had not been with the disciples and did not believe that Jesus had risen from the dead.

Jesus came and helped Thomas to understand.

We call him '**doubting Thomas**' because he would not believe until he had seen, heard and touched Jesus.

Faith is about believing even if you haven't seen something for yourself.

risen - to come back from the dead

tomb - a stone grave where the body of a dead

person is put
