





Key Facts

There are 5 oceans - Pacific, Atlantic, Arctic, Indian, Southern.
Antarctica is the largest desert. It is the coldest and windiest place on Earth.
Animals adapt to survive in their environment. Penguins are excellent swimmers. They use their short, stubby wings as flippers to help them glide in the water, and for tobogganing.

Antarctica	The continent around the South Pole covered by ice.
Continent	One of 7 huge areas of land.
Country	A large area of land with its own government and people.
Desert	A very dry area with few or no plants growing in it.
Habitat	A place where something lives.
Iceberg	A large floating mass of ice.
Mountain	High land with steep sides, bigger than a hill.
Ocean	A very large area water on the earth's surface.
Sand dune	A hill of sand built up by the wind.
Valley	Low land between hills or mountains.
