The fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness, self control.

The Ascension is when we remember when Jesus left the disciples to go back to heaven to be with God.

Ascension	When Jesus went to heaven to be with God.
Alpha	The beginning. Α
Crucified	How Jesus died, being killed on a cross.
Heaven	The place Jesus went back to, to be with God.
Omega	The end. Ω
Paschal candle	The special candle lit first on Easter day showing the symbols Alpha and Omega.
Pentecost	When God sent the Holy Spirit to be with the disciples.
Resurrected	When Jesus rose from the dead and came back to life.
Symbol	A number, letter, shape or picture to represent something.
