Key Vocabulary

RECONCILIATION The sacrament we receive when we confess and receive forgiveness for our sins.

FORGIVENESS - When someone forgives someone else, pardons or lets them off.

CONFESSION- In the Sacrament of Reconciliation when you tell the priest your sins.

ACT OF SORROW- A prayer to say how sorry we are for our sins.

ABSOLUTION - In the Sacrament of Reconciliation when the priest, in the place of Jesus, 'absolves', forgives your sins.

PENANCE - A prayer or something else to show we want to make things right with God, or others we have hurt.

ABSOLUTION - In the Sacrament of Reconciliation when the priest, in the place of Jesus, 'absolves', forgives your sins.
