National Curriculum Aims

- calculate and interpret the mean as an average.

Key Vocabulary

Average	A calculated central value of a set of numbers.
Axis	The "x" and "y" lines that cross at right angles to make a graph.
Construct	To draw a shape, line or angle accurately.
Data	A collection of facts, such as numbers, words, measurements and observations.
Interpret	Finding and understanding data from a graph/chart.
Line graph	Is a graph formed by joining the plotted points that represent given data.
Mean	A calculated central value of a set of numbers.
Pie Chart	A circular graph, which is divided into slices to illustrate numerical proportion.
Table	Information (such as numbers and descriptions) arranged in rows and columns



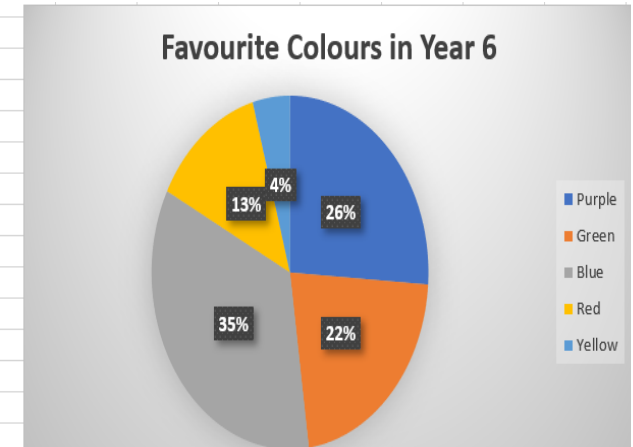
