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*Important Information.*  
Topics - will be taught in blocks and we will keep you up to date with all of this in the weekly learning intentions. Please ensure you check and read the learning intentions each week as we could ask for specific things.

Changing books- your child is responsible for changing their book when required. They will do this independently on arriving in the morning - with a reminder from us. Books will be given out next week when the assessments are complete.

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*Important Information.*  
Spellings  
The children will need to continue practicing their Year 1 and 2 words as well as the Year 3 and 4 words. Practice at home is essential!!!  
We will carry out termly spelling tests of these words to monitor and track their spelling progress.  
They will be given a new list of spellings each Tuesday that they will be tested on the following week.  
Spelling books need to be in school everyday, so we can check spellings are being practiced.


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*Home learning*  
1) Reading- aim for 10 minutes daily. This can include discussing the book with your child (characters, plot etc) or simply sharing a book at bedtime. Junior Librarian, Accelerated Reader in school.  
2) Times tables - by the end of Year 3 your child will be expected to know their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10. Practice at home is essential! Children should be on Times table rock stars for a minimum of 15 mins a week.  
3) Telling the time! - Discuss what the time will be when dinner's ready, how long until the train arrives etc.  
4) Online learning - Mathletics (homework set by teacher each week) and Times table rockstars. Please spend time with your child online and discuss e-safety. The children should know their passwords (they were all given them this week).  
5) Learning Logs - The children will be given a specific homework task each Friday to be completed in their Learning Log. The homework will be due the following Wednesday and will be linked to a learning objective that has been covered in the class.

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*Things to know about Year 3!*  
6) Spellings - The children will be given a list of spellings each Tuesday to learn at home. We will be completing a spelling test the following Tuesday to see which words have been learnt.  
7) Teacher planning and assessment time - Each week the class teacher has time out of the classroom to plan and assess the children's learning. During this time Madame Wallace will be teaching French and Mr Brewer will be teaching Computing.
