Subject		Learning				
English	Reading	Class Reading books - 5N – Varjack Paw 5D -The Explorer Guided Reading Comprehension – 3 sessions a week. Children will be discussing their understanding and meaning of words in context, using inference and finding key information. Daily independent reading in class				
	Writing	Myths - We will be exploring popular myths. Children will then be able to have a go at creating their own mythical story. Reports – Identifying the structure of a report and then creating our own reports linked to our Geography learning.				
Maths		Shape – drawing and measuring angles. Position and direction - using co-ordinates, lines of symmetry and reflections. Decimals – Adding and subtracting decimals.				
Religious Education		The risen Lord and Pentecost – discussing the Resurrection and its importance for us today. To understand how Jesus teaches us to pray and reflect on the importance of prayer for us.				
Science		Animals including humans – looking at the human timeline, how children change into adults and comparing animal and human life cycles.				
History		Study the Maya civilisation and compare to the Anglo Saxons. cA.D.900. Where did the Maya live? What were the significant events in the Maya's history? What were Maya city-states like? What did the Maya invent? What happened to the Maya city-states? Remember Britain and the Anglo Saxons and compare and contrast the lives of the Maya and Anglo-Saxons in cAD 900

PSHE		Topics linked to assembly themes including Unicef Rights of the Child.				
Primary Languages- French (KS2 only)		The children will learn to describe holiday destinations, holiday plans and will eventually create a French blog entry to describe a future holiday in detail.				
Art & Design inc Design Technology		Art – drawing – Exploring the purpose and impact of images from the 'Space race' era of the 1950s and 60s. DT - Learning about the features of installation art and how it can communicate a message.				
Music		Children will explore movie music from 1920s animated films to present day movies, learning techniques for creating soundtracks and film scores.				
Computing		Children will learn about different types of blogs, how to create a blog, add comments, incorporate media, and about vlogs and how to record a vlog.
