Cake Sale and Halloween Raffle

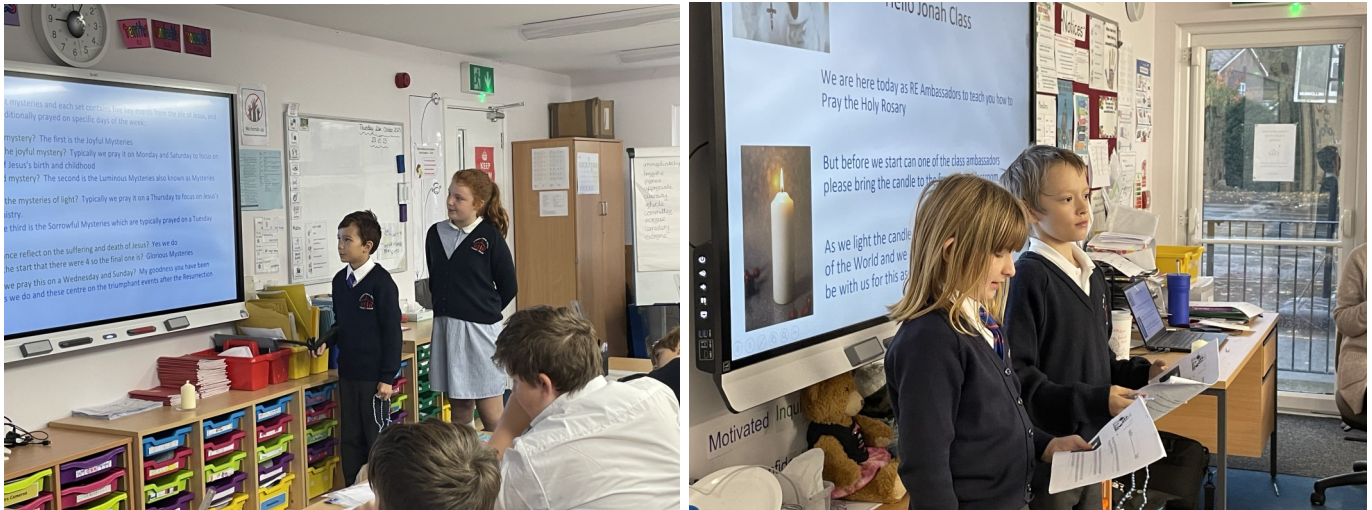
