This is a summary of the learning taking place for the half term beginning:

Subject		Learning
English	Reading	Class Reading books - 5N – Charlotte’s Web 5H - Charlotte’s Web Guided Reading Comprehension – 3 sessions a week. Children will be discussing their understanding and meaning of words in context, using inference and finding key information. Daily independent reading in class
	Writing	Narratives – story settings, characters, speech. Charlotte’s Web – Book study and character analysis Performance Poetry
Maths		Fractions – unit fractions, non-unit fractions, improper fractions, equivalent fractions, comparing fractions, ordering fractions, adding and subtracting fractions.
Religious Education		Prophecy and Promise – The life and story of David. Jesus fulfils the promises made to David. To listen to Psalm 23 and understand its significance. Understanding the importance of the Rosary and the role of Mary.
Science		Living things and their habitats – Lifecycle difference between mammals, amphibians, insects and birds. How do plants and animals reproduce. The work of Maria Merion on birds and butterflies.
History		Ancient Greeks - Chronology through the significant periods of time for Ancient Greeks. Beliefs of the Ancient Greeks. Comparison between the city-states of Athens and Sparta. Birth of democracy in Athens. Importance of theatre, myths and fables. Significance of the Battle of Marathon, Thermopylae and Salamis. Importance and purpose of Olympic Games. Impact Alexander the Great had on Ancient Greece.
Geography		Not this half-term.
PSHE		Topics linked to assembly themes including Unicef Rights of the Child.
