Subject		Learning
English	Reading	Independent Reading (15 mins a day) Class reader: The Lion the Witch and the Wardrobe & A Series of Unfortunate Events, The Wide Window. Guided Reading: Children will look through a variety of different texts such as poems, short stories, articles and letters and practise retrieving information from the text.
	Writing	To learn about and produce our own set of instructions and Narratives. Reintroduce Alan Peat's '2A, sentences' example: The old, abandoned house was still. Develop an increased understanding of Fronted adverbials, which is a year 4 curriculum objective.
Maths		Multiplication and Division- Multiplying and dividing by 3, 6, 7, 9, 12. Multiplying 3 numbers together, multiplying and dividing numbers by themselves and 1. Consolidation- Children will be revisiting different areas of our place value and addition and subtraction topic.
Religious Education		Branch Two: Prophecy and Promise- Miracle of the flour & oil. Elijah's encounter with God. Preaching of John the Baptist. The ancestry of Jesus. What is meant by 'Prophecy'. (1Kings 17, 19, Matt 1 & 3, Mark 1, Isiah 40,)
Science		States of Matter- What is matter? The 3 states of matter (Solid, Liquid and Gas), the process of melting, evaporation and condensation.
History		Anglo Saxons- Why did the Anglo Saxons come to Britain? Where did the Anglo Saxons come from? What did Anglo Saxon settlements look like? Case Study on Sutton Hoo.

PSHE		Myself and My Relationships: Friends and Family, Anti-Bullying - we are learning how to build positive relationships with friends and family, understand the importance of respect and kindness, and explore ways to prevent and respond to bullying. We aim to develop empathy, confidence, and strategies for maintaining healthy friendships and supporting others."
Primary Languages- French (KS2 only)		DESCRIBING OTHERS: The children will learn to describe a famous person and create a poster using full sentences. They will also learn a French Christmas Carol for the KS2 Carol Service.
Art & Design inc Design Technology		Structures - designing and making a helmet using strengthening techniques to reinforce the shell structure.
Computing		Creating toys. – The different types of toys, Inputs and Outputs. Use of Scratch to create inputs and outputs. Editing and debugging ideas for toys.
Music		Cornets – To learn how to use mouth pieces correctly and start playing a few notes.



PE	Football- Learn the basic rules of the game and skills such as, passing, dribbling, tackling and shooting. Dance (Cold places)- Children will create dance routines inspired by the theme 'cold places.'
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
